Challenge

A student in Virtual Enterprise shared that his mom was a teen center student and that she was very appreciative of help received. Student shared that the Vista High School Teen center and other centers in VUSD could benefit from toy donations.

Overview

Students first reached out to the Teen center coordinator to inform them of goals and asked how many children were in the program within VUSD also asked approximately the ages and gender breakdown. Students had to obtain boxes to collect items and coordinate where to place to reach out to collect items. Students created a flyer with information to go on boxes and to distribute to peers, family, neighbors and friends.
